## **Wedding Rentals at Campfire**

Effective Jan. 1st, 2024. Prices subject to change

- Usage of Campfire premises for your wedding date is \$3500 (No accommodation, but full use of the facilities including all of our inventory such as chairs, tables, dishes etc; meeting with the Property Manager; decorating one day prior to your event, and cleaning up one day after your event)
- If you plan to use the media/sound system (full large screen, DVD player, overhead projector, wireless mic and an audio-only apple box), that would be \$50
- If people want to sleep over at Campfire either before or after the wedding, we would charge them \$31/person/night. You would have to keep track of the numbers for us.
- If you plan to use the facilities for sleepover guests, these are the conditions:
- a) All groups are entitled to the use of the 16 beds spread over the 5 bedrooms in the Lodge. If the group is larger than 15 people, we will allot one extra cabin (cabins have combinations of bunk beds and queen beds). If the group is larger than 20 people, we will allot 2 extra cabins. If the group is larger than 30, we will allot 3 extra cabins and so on. This is all included in your per person fee.
- b) If, however a group would like to have more cabins than they have been allotted, they would be charged \$50/cabin/night.

-Campfire cannot be responsible for accidents and sickness incurred by our rental groups. All rental parties will be required to sign a **Rental Agreement and Waiver of Liability document.** (I have attached a copy for you.)

-As a condition of renting the Campfire property, institutional groups and wedding rentals are
required to obtain liability insurance for the period of their rental. We suggest a limited polic
of \$2,000,000 for event liability insurance. If the group is serving alcohol, the policy must
contain a clause about coverage for hosting alcohol. Groups must provide the Rental
Coordinator with a certificate of insurance by emailing it to the Rental Coordinator two week
prior to the beginning of the rental ()
